Baby Room

This term in the Baby Room our topic is All About Me and Autumn. Over the next few weeks, we will be exploring our senses and the world around us. We use this term to get to know all the children within the room and make sure they are completely settled in.





Pooh Bear Room

We are also covering All About Me and Autumn. We will be getting creative with different ways to learn about our body parts, using a range of different media and materials. We have also added in some baking to our planning, and alongside this we are focusing on our maths too.







Preschool Learning Zone

This term in Preschool our topic is 'All About Me' where we will be learning about ourselves, our families, where we live and our feelings. The children are starting the term by painting their own self-portraits and learning to recognise the letters in their names. We will also be introducing phonics to the younger children through the Jolly Phonics Scheme.

Show and Tell: we like to encourage children to bring in items from home to correspond with the letter of the week, this builds the children's confidence and ability to speak in front of others.
